NA MAILING LISTS AND DEVELOPMENT APPLICATIONS

OVERVIEW

The [Bend Oregon Online Mapper](#) (BOOM), is the City of Bend's publically-accessible online mapping tool. It is a geographic information system (GIS) that helps us gather, manage, and analyze data using location. It is a great tool for generating mailing lists by neighborhood association boundary or looking up active development applications within a neighborhood.

NEIGHBORHOOD ASSOCIATION MAILING LISTS

Follow the steps outlined below to generate a mailing list of taxlots (property owners) for neighborhood association mailings.

INSTRUCTIONS

- Access BOOM online mapping tool: www.bendoregon.gov/maps
- Click "I Agree"
- Click on "Layers" in the bottom left-hand corner
- Check the box next to "Neighborhood Associations"
- Click "I want to..."
- Click "Find data and information on the map"
- Click the map in the NA of interest
- In the "Identify Results" panel, click on the NA name (the map will zoom out)
- Zoom in on the NA until tax lot lines appear
- In the "Neighborhood Assoc..." panel, click the menu icon
- Click "Show Buffer Options"
- Enter "0" for the "Distance"
- Click "Continue"
- In the "Identify Results" panel, click the menu icon
- Click "Switch to Table"
- In the "Identify Results" panel, click the menu icon
- Click "Export to XLSX"
- Download Excel file to computer



LOOK UP ACTIVE DEVELOPMENT APPLICATIONS

Follow the steps outlined below to lookup the active land use applications within your neighborhood association boundary.

INSTRUCTIONS

- Access BOOM online mapping tool: www.bendoregon.gov/maps
- Click “I Agree”
- Click on “Layers” in the bottom left-hand corner
- Check the box next to “Neighborhood Associations”
- Click the “+” next to “Permits and Land Use”
- Check the box next to “Planning Applications”
- Zoom in to your NA boundary until blue triangles are visible
- Right click on a blue triangle
- Click “Find data on the map”
- The application(s) for that property will be listed in “identify Results” panel
- Click “ePlans Public” to view the application in ePlans
